






















Join us for our 2024 Premiere Trip as we visit 6 countries on this spectacular 15 day adventure. We'll sail to some of the most well-known landmarks in the world, retrace some of Paul's incredible missionary journeys, and study Scripture in the very places it was written. In addition to breathtaking views, deluxe accommodations, and mouthwatering breakfast, lunch, & dinners onboard our ship (included in the price), we'll be inspired throughout the trip with Bible studies that examine Paul's journeys and applications from the Bible for today. Come expecting to be challenged with Biblical teachings, inspiring hymn sings, laughter and Christian fellowship on this once-in-alifetime Mediterranean highlights trip! For all our Premiere Trips you can expect an immersive experience featuring many inclusions and extras (such as tipping onboard, excursions, and transfers) as well as a limited number of guests for a more personal experience.

May 14 - Arrive in Barcelona, Spain

Our expedition begins as we arrive in Barcelona. We check in to our deluxe hotel for two nights and enjoy dinner.

May 15 – Barcelona, Spain

We'll have a full day tour of the highlights of Barcelona including Casa Mila, Casa Battlo, the renowned Ramblas Boulevard & stop for photos outside the breathtaking La Sagrada Família Cathedral, Barcelona's most famous landmark. See the Parque de la Ciutadella, Villa Olímpica, Puerto Olympic, La Barceloneta, and finally reach the mountain of Montjuic for panoramic views of the city. Our day also includes entrance to Gaudi's Bizarre Parc Guell, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Breakfast & dinner are included.

May 16 - Board the Voyager Of The Seas

After breakfast, our chartered coaches take us to the port of Barcelona to embark on the beautiful Voyager of the Seas, our home away from home for the next 11 nights.

May 17 - Nice, France

We'll see highlights of the French Rivera today such as Hotel Negresco, an artistic monument, built in 1912, where many nobles and kings from all over Europe have visited. We head to Monaco to visit the old city, walk through the city passing the houses that belong to the princesses Carolina and Estefanía. Then you go to the Cathedral of San Nicolás and visit the Plaza del Palacio with some free time to explore. Next, we visit Monte Carlo whose square is surrounded by the Café de París, the Hotel París Montecarlo and more.

May 18 - Rome (Civitavecchia), Italy

Explore the wonders of ancient Rome when we see the magnificent Coliseum, Roman Forum, the Circus Maximus, the Arch of Titus, and the Appian Way and walk underground as we learn about church history in the St Callixtus Catacombs used by the early church. Time permitting, we'll visit the historic Pantheon, the graceful Spanish Steps, or stop at the famous Trevi Fountain.

May 19 – Naples, Italy

Arrive in Naples, a dazzling city perched on a beautiful rock coast. Paul landed in the bay of Naples on his way to Rome. We journey inland to the ancient Roman city of Pompeii where we'll learn about Roman civilization and see the spectacular ruins that were covered by ash from the eruption of Mt. Vesuvius in A.D. 79.







May 20 – At Sea

On sea days (and some evenings) we'll enjoy Bible studies, singing, and special events with our speakers and artists. Relax and enjoy the pools, hot tubs, fitness center, spa, and sports complex onboard or sit on deck with complimentary coffee, tea, or soft ice cream & enjoy the scenery. Plus, the ship has complimentary miniature golf, ice skating, rock climbing wall, and featured events like their professional ice skating shows.

May 21 - Valletta, Malta

We visit the breathtaking island of Malta, where Paul's shipwreck occurred. We'll view the traditional site of Paul's shipwreck, St Paul's Bay & Island and the commemorative statue of Paul (built in 1748). We'll visit Paul's Grotto where Paul is said to have baptized Publius, the governor of Malta. Plus, we'll visit the breathtaking St. John's Co-Cathedral and the beautiful St Paul's Shipwreck Church built in 1609.

May 22 - At Sea

Be refreshed and encouraged with Bible studies and special events plus time to relax onboard. As always, meals onboard are included (buffets, casual, & 5 course formal dining options each day). Come expecting endless options such as steaks, shrimp, lobster, and many international flavors your tastebuds are sure to savor. Plus, enjoy healthy options and endless desserts!

May 23 - Rhodes, Greece

(On your own) or join us for an optional tour to Lindos, the most beautiful village on the island. We'll see the Acropolis, the remains of a Byzantine Church and the fortification of the Knights of St. John. From the top you may look down on St. Paul's Bay, where it is said the Apostle first set foot on the island in the year 52 AD. We'll enjoy walking streets of Lindos, visit its medieval church, see the Acropolis of ancient Rhodes. Also experience the Gate of D'Amboise, guided through the Medieval City, Grand Master Palace and Hospital of the Knights.

May 24 - Ephesus, Turkey

Another highlight of our trip will be the ancient city of Ephesus, where Paul spent three years. The ruins have been restored similar to Paul's time. We'll see the Agora, Basilica of St John, Museum of Ephesus, & view the 25,000 seat Great Theater. We'll also view the Temple of Artemis (Diana), one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World which Paul wrote about. We'll see the Celsus Library, the Roman Baths, & visit the famous terrace houses.

May 25 - Santorini, Greece

(On your own) or join to explore Santorini, one of the most beautiful of the Greek Islands. Its picturesque whitewashed villages with brilliant blue domes dot the cliffs above the Aegean Sea. The island itself perches on the edges of a volcano that erupted 3,500 years ago. Join us as we take a spectacular guided "highlights of the island" tour to the most photographed & scenic spots on the island.

May 26 - Mykonos, Greece


(On your own) or join us on our guided tour of some of the most famous beaches, important sites, small private chapels and houses built in typical Cycladic' style. We'll enjoy the distinctive whitewashed structures and cobblestone streets, the Monastery of Panagia Tourliani, Chora, the famous windmills, and beautiful Little Venice!

May 27 Corinth & Athens Greece

After breakfast, we say goodbye to our ship and head to Corinth. We'll see the Ancient Agora and the Temple of Apollo mentioned in the Bible. Stand on the Bema where Paul stood. Read Paul's letter to the Corinthians and visualize his address to the Gentiles as he began the task of building Corinth's church. In Athens, we view the world-renowned Acropolis, the Propylaea, and the Parthenon. You'll have the opportunity to climb Mars Hill where Paul debated with the intellectual community of his day. We check into our hotel and have our final dinner together.

May 28 Athens, Greece

After breakfast, our coach drops us off at Athens (ATH) airport.
